#### Organizing Committee January 16 meeting highlights

There was no quorum.

#### General Update (Bob Hamaguchi)

- Ford Foundation has committed to fund to JCCCNC/JTF to move to formation of a community land trust. Most likely a 6 month process to get it done. 1st meeting targeted for late February.

#### BNP Draft Update (Steve Wertheim)

- Steve presented the 7 section very rough draft where sections 4 (Existing Conditions) and 5 (Recommendation) were detailed out.
- The current draft (All sections) will be completed by 2/1.
- Steve reviewed an accompanying document which will be incorporated into the final draft which discusses which items of concerns are addressed by various tools in the new document.
- Desired target is to bring this plan to the planning commission and historic preservation commission in June.
- Steve desires a kickoff community meeting before 3/1 -- targeting 2/23

#### Supervisor London Breed Addresses the Committee

- Supervisor Breed discussed the neighborhood action plan as "turning back the clock" and "bringing communities together".
- Will serve on the Board of Supervisor's Budget and Finance Committee which is rare for a freshman supervisor
- Main office will be at city hall with a neighborhood meeting venue at African American Art and Culture Complex at 762 Fulton Street
